

FROM THE DEACON CHAIR

Friends,

What a wonderful advent season we had at Broadway this year! Every service was well planned and executed allowing us to truly focus and meditate on the Gift in a reverent manner. Many thanks to each minister for the teamwork and organization that took place behind the scenes to ensure success. Also, special thanks to Connie Rogers and the decorations team for the beautiful church adornment. Many hours of work and planning went into making our church so beautiful and we are so appreciative of your time and efforts.

Your new slate of deacons has already had their first meeting and it is a talented group, indeed! The body is hard at work supporting the ministers and planning for the new year. We request your prayers as we help lead the church on God's chosen path. Our goal is to assist the ministers in guiding the work and welfare of the church and most importantly to be servants in extending the ministry to our congregation.

Thanks to a generous endowment gift, we have begun the installation of a new security system. There will be 8 exterior cameras installed giving us almost a 360 degree view of the perimeter of the church. Electronic locking systems will be installed on the entrance doors to the family life center and friendship hall. This will allow us to program entrance to these heavy traffic areas for set times and allow for codes to be set-up for off-peak entrance. The door camera/release system in the office is also being updated to allow more flexibility in unlocking the door for daytime visitors. Finally, we are also in the process of reviewing an upgrade to the existing phone system. All of the security devices should be installed by the end of January helping our church become more secure and accessible.

It is certainly a time of great excitement and anticipation at Broadway with our new pastor and a great team of ministers. Broadway has a bright future and we encourage you to give of your time and talent so that we might fully optimize the plans God has to prosper us. Please know that you are always encouraged to provide feedback and thoughts to any member of the deacon body.
