

Beloved Broadway,

As we turn another calendar page, I wanted to update you on a few "housekeeping" matters at church.

First, in case you have not heard, Nora and I are expecting a new baby (no idea on the sex of the baby, we are waiting to be surprised again) mid-February. I am deeply grateful for the two-weeks of Family Leave our personnel policy allows, **so I will be out essentially February 13 to February 27 (depending on the exact timing of this little bundle of joy).** During that time, please contact our Associate Pastor for Spiritual Formation, Rev. Susan Reed, for immediate Pastoral Care needs. The rest of the Pastoral Team is available, but Susan will serve as our pastoral care point-person for the time. I am so grateful for this whole staff team who function at such a high level that Nora and I will be able to have this precious time together in these first moments of this mystery baby's life.

Second, Ann Hale started as our new Ministry Coordinator, so I hope you will join us in welcoming her! You can now reach her at ann@broadwaybaptist.org. Ann will be serving our congregation and staff in a much needed collaborative role. Her primary areas of coordination are Care and Calendar. We are building our processes currently, but I wanted to give you a heads up on where we are so far (She will also take on managing our membership roles and database from Robin Riddle who has served as our volunteer Membership Manager for over 5 years. Robin, thank you for your service during quite a long interim period!). Ann will be with us for 15 hours per week, so to make her as effective as possible, we have some processes we need to put into place.

With regards to **Care**, Ann is helping managing the lists of care needs to empower our Pastoral Team to better care for you as our church family. She is managing the prayer lists and the homebound member list, and working with our two Deacon Ministry Teams (the Care Team and the Homebound Team) to ensure their lists are up-to-date and accurate. **So, what do you need to know? If you have a prayer concern or need to talk to a minister, nothing changes for you. Call or text Susan, Robert, Amanda, Alissa, or me anytime. We are here for you.** If you would like to add a name to the Prayer List, you can still call the church office or email Candace or Ann. If you have a private prayer concern that you do not wish to be on the Worship Folder each week, we will hold your concern with discretion. What does change is our behind the scenes structures of care: how deacons are connected in to reach out, how we keep track of our folks in transition, grief, or concern so that no one falls through the cracks. We still only know what you share with us, so please don't hesitate to reach out if you would be comfortable with us visiting you at the hospital, at home, or checking in on you.

As for the <u>Calendar</u>, if you have a building usage request, a meeting you want to schedule, an event you are hosting, just email ann@broadwaybaptist.org. From there, Ann will send you a list of questions, so that we can capture the details for our staff and sexton support. We will strive to get back to you in a timely manner. As we update our Google Calendar and ensure that what is happening in the building is reflected online and conflict-free in scheduling, we appreciate your grace as we get a process in place.


