A Letter from the Pastor...



Beloved Broadway,

Happy New Year! As we turn the calendar page together, new beginnings abound as 2024 arrives. We began a spiritual practice last year when New Year's Day fell on January 1, 2023. As an element in worship, we drew "star words," a decade old Protestant prayer practice connected to Epiphany and the New Year. Often we make resolutions for New Year's; actions we "resolve" to do in order to "better" ourselves. Think of a star word as your intention for the year. Not an action, per se, but a posture or perspective to bring into your daily life. For me, I drew the word "Imagine," which encouraged me to trust God more deeply, to think more creatively, and to love more fully. Never could I have imagined what God would do in our life together in 2023 when I drew that card which has remained in my wallet since January 1.

When we first drew star words last year, I had no idea what to expect. We laid out the card face down, so as each person came forward and collected their card for the year, they did so randomly. While random, oh the stories I heard!

One visitor at the time (Janet Seron Waddle, who ended up joining our church this year) drew a Welsh word, Cwtch (pronounced "kuh-tch," meaning "holding someone in your arms"). This sparked a chain of memories for Jan, since Jan is Welsh on her maternal side. Her grandmother, a kindly Welsh woman, died when Jan's mom was only 2 years old. Then at 12 years old, Jan's mom immigrated to the United States from Wales with her father and two older sisters (Jan's grandfather and aunts). Jan's grandfather remarried a woman who was described as "the evil stepmother" who when Jan's mom was 15 years old, forced her to sleep in an enclosed, but unheated porch in Northern Illinois during the winter, and she took ill. One of her older sisters found her one day, and the stepmother dismissed Jan's mom's illness. Jan's aunt ran to find a doctor, who came to the house in the dead of winter, wrapped Jan's 15 year old mother in his arms (cwtch!), and carried her to a hospital. She lived to 95 years of age, and never forgot her Welsh roots and that doctor's kindness. So much memory stored in a single star word.

I cannot promise or share with you what intention the Holy Spirit is inviting you to hold this year. However, I do hope that God might give us clarity and courage to look to the stars, like the Magi of old, and follow faithfully. May God's stars illuminate our path as we begin this journey of 2024 together. Happy New Year, friends.


