### A Letter from the Pastor

Beloved Broadway,

These are good days. Our Minister to Youth search has come to a marvelous conclusion with the unanimous calling of Alissa Vance at Quarterly Business Meeting in February. Alissa is a first year at Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary, and a recent graduate of DePaul University in Chicago. Alissa is a Louisville native, and when I spoke with her Youth Minister from Beargrass Christian where she grew up she sang Alissa's praises far and wide. Out of the interviews we did have, Alissa was the only candidate who expressed a truly deep excitement and curiosity about working with youth. With a sincerity and joy she said multiple times, "I really can't wait to meet them." After getting to spend Passport Camp and DiscipleNow with our youth, I can honestly say they are some of the funniest, brightest, coolest, and most mature youth I have known in



17 years of ordained Gospel ministry. Alissa is going to be a blessing to our youth, an asset on our Staff Team, and a gift to our church family.

As we turn the page towards Lent, our theme for this year is Seeking: Honest Questions for Deeper Faith. Lent provides us an annual invitation to shed the scales from our eyes and see ourselves, our lives, our relationships, and our God with fresh eyes. Starting anew is one of the hardest tasks we do, but this work is necessary. Like piercing dried clods of dirt with holy plough-shares, we turn the earth over and over until enough fodder, light, and oxygen bring the soil of our souls back to life. Every new season beckons something of us—attention, beauty, the chance to create.

This season is no different. So, like moths to the light, will we find our way toward God, or will we hover, circling fake suns? I am seeking something deeper. I am kicking off my shoes. I am starting this season on holy ground.




