In 1875, just five years after Broadway Baptist Church was founded on Broadway in 1870, the first Kentucky Derby was held at Churchill Downs. Affectionately dubbed, "The Most Exciting Two Minutes in Sports," the Derby is a reminder of what it takes to be a champion. The great steed is topped with the tiniest of jockeys, and together they soar at full steam with a world of eyes fixed on them for two eternal minutes.

Mary Lucy Hook once explained to Nora and me how each of the horses are given a "barn buddy," a fellow horse to nuzzle in the barn and walk with around the Paddock and track before races. This helps the running horse acclimate to the crowd's noise and calm their nerves. Even Derby Champions need an encouraging friend to walk with them in life.

With Derby season waking our city out of her winter slumber, I am reminded of the writer of Hebrews who used this racing metaphor in a masterful way when he or she wrote in 12:1-2.

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith...

There are no solo-Christians. We are all stars in the great constellation of saints—those witnesses who cheer us on from the balconies of life. The great 20th-Century Baptist preacher, Carlyle Marney, used to say that a person is like a house. There is a parlor for welcoming people. A kitchen for cooking and breaking bread with family and friends. There is a living room for studying and reflecting on our God's good grace and life's deep mysteries.

There is also a balcony–a balcony filled with the people who have loved you and encouraged you all the days of your life. Marney proclaimed, "Walk outside and look up and see who's up there on your balcony looking down at you. Wave to them. They are your saints."

Our race is not two-minutes long but a life-time long, and God has given each of us companions, colleagues, and balcony people to encourage us and challenge us to run the race with perseverance and persistence. We will stumble. We will lag from time to time. But, by God's good grace, we will finish stronger together.


