
## ANGEL TREE



## A Letter from the Pastor...

#### Beloved Broadway,

Being from a State with two seasons (Hot and Hades), I adore the four seasons of Kentucky but especially Fall. The autumnal transition seems to slow the soul to find a little more silence and solitude. In Henri Nouwen's The Way of the Heart, which we have been reading together on Wednesday nights this past month, he writes, "We have, indeed, to fashion our own desert where we can withdraw every day, shake off our compulsions, and dwell in the gentle healing presence of our Lord." The desert for Henri is the quiet place where Jesus went to seek solitude and communion with God. There is a difference between isolation and solitude. In isolation, one is stuck, trapped, and disconnected. In solitude, we recognize God's omnipresence which keeps us

connected in love even when we are far apart. Our fashioned desert, according to Henri, might be a favorite old chair perfectly situated with good light for reading or a view of a world full of green leaves becoming ablaze with autumn color. My favorite "fashioned desert" in Houston was on Thursday evenings, I would go to the Museum of Fine Art down the street from the office and wander for an hour or so through the corridors covered in curated pieces which over time became like familiar old friends. Where is your fashioned desert? Where are you able to retreat to seek solitude and set aside the demands of the day? Retreat does not have to mean surrender, and stepping away from the chaos to let the Holy Spirit refresh your body and soul is not weakness but wisdom. As St. Augustine of Hippo once wrote in his Confessions, "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You." May the changing of the season open our eyes to God's renewal and presence around us and within us. Grace & Peace,
