A Letter from the Pastor...

Beloved Broadway,

As we come to the close of this year, we are thankful for so much in 2022. With the waning of Covid-19, we are back to our regular pre-Pandemic attendance in worship on Sunday mornings of around 200 folks. However, we consistently have another 140-200 who worship with us on online through our livestream thanks to the Audio / Visual Team's herculean efforts each week (In 2022, we have had 1,168 unique viewers according to Vimeo, our streaming service).

I'd like to share three words of gratitude for the work of our 2023 Personnel Committee:

- -First and foremost, our Lead Sexton and the keeper of the keys, James Williams, has been with Broadway for 25 years. The title "Sexton" comes from the Medieval Latin "secristanus" which means the caretaker of sacred things. I cannot think of a more faithful, committed, kind, and warm keeper of our sacred home here at Broadway than James Williams. James does more quiet tending of our space and people than we could possible count or measure. He is a blessing to Broadway, and we are so grateful for his years of service. - –Second, I know Baptists don't really play the lottery (depends on the Baptist, I guess) but we struck a liturgical goldmine when God brought us our Organist, Jonathan Oblander. If you missed his concert, the room was filled with music, beauty, and folks eager to soak in the songs Jonathan shared. Each week, he brings an acumen and musicality that we would be hard pressed to find in many churches in our nation let alone our city. Knowing, working with, and worshiping alongside Jonathan this past year has truly been a joy for me personally and for our church collectively.
- -Finally, I want to offer an enthusiastic thanks to our Interim Youth Minister, Alix Davidson, who is wrapping up her interim work on December 18. In the past few years, Alix has been our Personnel Chair, served on the Pastoral Search Committee, and also served as our Interim Minister to Children a number of years ago. We are blessed as a congregation to have her as a leader in our church family. Alix's professional commitments with her work and leadership at the Food Literacy Project continue to increase (the curse of the capable!), and her original commitment to us was until Labor Day. Needless to say, she has gone above and beyond, and we are incredibly grateful for her service and ministry with our youth and our lay leaders in the youth ministry. She will still be around as a youth worker (she loves these kids dearly), and while her time on staff is coming to a close, we are grateful for her continued leadership and friendship here at Broadway.

As we close the books for November, we are \$205,475 away from our budgeted giving goal for 2022. With a challenging economy and once-in-a-generation inflation, we are faring better than we could have imagined. As we all close out our generosity journeys this year, I hope we can all finish strong with our End of Year Giving. Thank you for your support for the mission and ministry here at Broadway.


